THE JOYFUL MYSTERIES

The First Joyful Mystery – The Annunciation

(Luke 1: 26-38)

The Archangel Gabriel announces to the Blessed Virgin that she has been chosen to be the Mother of God. She responds, “Be it done unto me according to Thy Word.”

The Second Joyful Mystery – The Visitation

(Luke 1: 39-56)

And when Elizabeth heard the greeting of Mary, the babe leaped in her womb; and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit and she exclaimed with a loud cry, “Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb! And why is this granted me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me?”

The Third Joyful Mystery – The Birth of Jesus

(Luke 2: 1-20)

And she gave birth to her first-born son and wrapped him in swaddling cloths, and laid him in a manger, because there was no place for them in the inn.

The Fourth Joyful Mystery – The Presentation of Jesus in the Temple

(Luke 2:21-38)

Simeon took him up in his arms and blessed God and said, “Lord, now let thy servant depart in peace, according to thy word for mine eyes have seen thy salvation which thou hast prepared in the presence of all peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and for glory to thy people Israel.”

The Fifth Joyful Mystery – The finding of Jesus in the Temple

(Luke 2:41-52)

And when they did not find him, they returned to Jerusalem, looking for him. After three days they found him in the temple, sitting among the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions; and all who heard him were amazed at his understanding and his answers.

THE SORROWFUL MYSTERIES

The First Sorrowful Mystery – The Agony of Jesus in the Garden (Luke 22:39-46)

And he withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and knelt down and prayed, "Father, if thou art willing, remove this cup from me; nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done."..... He was in such agony and he prayed so fervently that his sweat became like drops of blood falling on the ground.

The Second Sorrowful Mystery – The Scourging at the Pillar (Matthew 27:15-26)

Then Pilate released for them Barabbas, and having scourged Jesus, delivered him to be crucified.

The Third Sorrowful Mystery – Jesus is Crowned with Thorns (Matthew 27:27-31)

And plaiting a crown of thorns the soldiers put it on his head, and put a reed in his right hand. And kneeling before him they mocked him, saying, "Hail, King of the Jews!" And they spat upon him, and took the reed and struck him on the head.

The Fourth Sorrowful Mystery – Jesus Carries the Cross (John 19:16-17)

Then Pilate handed him over to be crucified. So they took Jesus, and he went out, bearing his own cross, to the place called the place of a skull, which is called in Hebrew, Golgotha.

The Fifth Sorrowful Mystery – The Crucifixion of Our Lord (Luke 23:33-49)

It was now about the sixth hour, and there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour, while the sun's light failed; and the curtain of the temple was torn in two. Then Jesus, crying with a loud voice, said, "Father, into thy hands I commit my spirit!" And having said this he breathed his last.

THE GLORIOUS MYSTERIES

The First Glorious Mystery – The Resurrection of Jesus Christ (Luke 24:1-12)

...and as they were frightened and bowed their faces to the ground, the men said to them, “Why do you seek the living among the dead? Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee, that the Son of man must be delivered into the hands of ,

The Second Glorious Mystery – The Ascension of Jesus to Heaven (Acts 1:6-12)

And when he had said this, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight. And while they were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes, and said, “Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven.”

The Third Glorious Mystery – The Descent of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:1-13)

And suddenly a sound came from heaven like the rush of a mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared to them tongues as of fire, distributed and resting on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

The Fourth Glorious Mystery – The Assumption of Mary into Heaven (Catechism of the Catholic Church, Par. 974)

The Most Blessed Virgin Mary, when the course of her earthly life was completed, was taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven, where she already shares in the glory of her Son’s resurrection, anticipating the resurrection of all members of His Body.

The Fifth Glorious Mystery – The Coronation of Mary (Revelation 12:1)

And a great portent appeared in heaven, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars...

THE LUMINOUS MYSTERIES

The First Luminous Mystery – The Baptism in the Jordan (Matthew 34:16-17)

And when Jesus was baptized....The heavens were opened and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and alighting on Him, and lo, a voice from the heaven, saying, “This is My beloved son, with whom I am well pleased.”

The Second Luminous Mystery – The Wedding at Cana (John 2:5-7)

His mother said to the servants, “Do whatever He tells you.” Jesus said to them, “Fill the jars with water,” and they filled them up to the brim.

The Third Luminous Mystery – The Proclamation of The Kingdom (Matthew 10:7-8)

“....and preach as you go, saying, “The kingdom of heaven is at hand.” Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, cast out demons. You received without pay, give without pay.

The Fourth Luminous Mystery – The Transfiguration (Luke 9:29,35)

And he was praying, the appearance of his countenance was altered, and his raiment became dazzling white. And a voice came out of the cloud saying, “This is My Son, My chosen; listen to him!”

The Fifth Luminous Mystery – The Institution of the Eucharist (Luke 22:19-20)

He took bread, and when He had given thanks He broke it and gave it to them, saying, “This is My body which is given for you” and likewise the cup after supper, saying, “This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in My blood.”

HAIL, HOLY QUEEN

He was won by thy shining, sweet Star of the Sea!

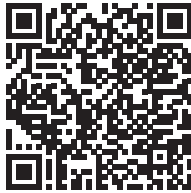
O COME TO THE THRONE OF GRACE
